## **SOLAR POLICY**

The City of Williams does not participate in any net metering/billing credit program. Meaning any electricity produced from an approved solar system that exceeds the individual's use, there will be no credit on their billing. Any electricity metered off the City's electric system will be billed accordingly.

Procedure for permitting of a solar system install as follows:

- 1. Submit a complete Building Permit Application with the solar plans.
- 2. The solar plans/design must be stamped by a certified electrical engineer or an approved solar design specialist.
- 3. When application and solar design is received, the plans will be reviewed by APS (the City's contracted operator of our electric system) and when approved the City's Building Dept. will then process your permit and fees. When fees are paid and permit and solar policy is signed you can then proceed with your project.
- 4. The permit can be signed by the installer but the solar policy must be signed by the owner. The owner needs to acknowledge that the City of Williams does not offer a Net Billing Credit program.
- 5. A schedule of required inspections will be noted on the Building Permit.
