

Hi Pam, thank you for this opportunity to represent the City of Williams with the insurance coverage renewing on 4-1-23. As a simple summary and ignoring the declines I sent there were two actual quotes that came in. The two carriers that provided terms are Travelers and Munich (incumbent carrier). You have both proposals, but one stands out from the other in a big way.

<u>Travelers</u> quote for the property and casualty lines of coverage came in at \$271,257.00 BUT EXCLUDES COVERAGE FOR THE DAMS AND THE ELECTRIC UTILITY! If Travelers is chosen, you would be bare of coverage for these important line items for the term you are with Travelers.

<u>Munich</u> quote for these lines of coverage came in at \$294,200 and INCLUDES COVERAGE FOR THE DAMS AND ELECTRIC UTILITY!

Note- there is an increase in the premium with Munich because the posted budget for the city online is increased and EVERY carrier has that as a rating function. Also, we had to increase the buildings valuations to try the best we can to keep up with this inflation we are experiencing, the labor shortage and issues with the supply chain to get building materials and the costs related with the same.
